Since 1983, **year 7-13 students** each year participate and compete at the WITT Taranaki Science and Technology Fair.

More than **60 schools** are eligible from all over Taranaki to participate in this fantastic **3 day event**. The fair offers students the opportunity to solve real life problems with their innovative ideas and projects.

Students showcase their work and projects In front of **hundreds of visitors** at the fair, hoping to get a placing and be rewarded with some of the many prizes at stake!

The WITT Taranaki Science and Technology Fair represents an opportunity for local businesses and organisations to participate in this community event. Every year, more than 50 companies and organisations are involved in the fair, supporting this educational event through generous sponsorship.

Why Should You Be Involved?

The WITT Taranaki Science & Technology Fair has only been able to continue each year due to the support of its sponsors, whose involvement in this event is essential.

Sponsors are highlighted during the dignitaries function and the prize giving, which they are invited to attend. During the prize giving ceremony, sponsors are given the option of presenting their own prizes.

A photographer is present during the WITT Taranaki Science & Technology Fair to take photos of the winners, their project and the event itself. All sponsors can access these pictures to promote their involvement in the fair too.



How Can You Be Involved?

Sponsorship Options

- Finances: This can be given to the fair's committee, who will then allocate the money as they see fit to organise and manage the fair
- Special prizes: You can decide to create a special prize related to your own business area (e.g. if you work in the water supply area, you can fund a special prize which would be awarded to a water-related work)
- A tertiary scholarship: This would be for education on a scientific or technological course for tertiary study
- Prize money: You can contribute to the prize money awarded to the students
- Vouchers & gifts


Depending on their donation, our sponsors are ranked as followed:


